Episode 5: To Strengthen Eternal Values

INT. DYLAN'S ROOM - MORNING

TUCKER

DYLAN

TUCKER

What's that?

Dylan finishes the tree and shows it to Tucker. It has a message written with a pen on it. It says: CHEER UP! Tucker just look at it with an uninterested face.

TUCKER

For a second I thought it would be something worthy.

Tucker takes his backpack and head out to the door.

TUCKER  
I'm leaving.

DYLAN  
(taking his stuff)  
Hey, wait for me!

Both of them head out to the school, while the camera FOCUS on the CHEER UP! message on the origami figure.

SCREEN

Intro.

INT. SALA DE JUNTAS - MORNING

The five ambassadors are gathered together in a classroom. Jennifer is at the front with some papers and stuff. Dylan is sitted at the front with his notebook open and taking notes. Melissa is behind Dylan she seems a little out of place and nervous. Jake is at the back distracted drawing something in a paper. Eddy is next to Melissa and is not very interested either in the topic, but still is paying attention. Jennifer is trying to talk to them.

JENNIFER  
So, the good news is that the principal haven't say anything negatively lately, which means we are doing kind of a good job. But that doesn't means we can relax and do nothing about it. Still I can see how the henchmen are always near and ready to caught us.

EDDY  
They sure are watching.

JENNIFER  
Anyways, now that you finally speak, I noticed you finished the list I gave you. The field outside seems kind of organize, better at least, and I heard some good comments about how you helped during Bible Lab. That's good.

Eddy just shrugs not very enthusiastic.

JENNIFER  
Anything else I should know?

EDDY

Not really.

DYLAN

(excited looking his list)

Me! I've got some cool stuff to show!

JENNIFER

Wait Dylan, we are taking turns.

DYLAN

(dissapointed)

Ah!

JENNIFER

So, Melissa, so far what have you accomplish? Did you finish the list I gave you?

MELISSA

(a little shy)

Ehm... well... I did help some of my classmates during classes with their homeworks.

JENNIFER

Mmm... not exactly what I marked, but I guess...

(sighs)

Look, to be honest I don't think that really help us. We need to do something that other teachers or the principal can see, otherwise it's nonsense. The principal will never know what we are doing.

DYLAN

Aren't we suppose to help others as a secrecy?

JENNIFER

Not when our grades are at stake. We need the principal to realize our efforts otherwise we will keep loosing time and points.

EDDY

I have to agree on that, kid.

Dylan seems a little confused. Melissa also feels a little dissapointed. Jennifer tries to fix her papers.

JENNIFER

Well, it doesn't matter. Is okay, at least you are trying it. I'll try to help you with some other stuff when I see the chance.

Jennifer writes something in her notebook and then turns to look at Jake who is at the back still drawing.

JENNIFER

So, Jake. You have anything to tell us?

DYLAN

(raising his hand)

I do if you ask me.

Jake turns and look at her. She has a serious face. Everybody is looking at him.

JAKE

Well... I've been around... helping too.

JENNIFER

Doing what exactly?

JAKE

Well, stuff. You see, I don't keep track of what I do to help. I'm not that selfish.

JENNIFER

I gave you a list, did you even took your time to read it?

Jake tries to nod and say something, but stops midway.

JAKE

Well, the thing is that some of them were way too complicated to handle by myself, so I found my own stuff to do.

JENNIFER

As what?

JAKE

You know, keeping things clean, helping others... doing some stuff. Anyways, what are you even doing on first place? You seem to like being

the boss.

JENNIFER

Well, I don't like to brag about it, but I have done pretty cool stuff you'll see. I helped Mrs. Smith with the new choir project, I also offer myself to take care of the recycling stuff, and volunteering with some departments for one hour work and I'm also getting involve in the S.A. activities.

DYLAN

Wow, that is epic!

Jake doesn't says anything.

JENNIFER

As I imagined you wouldn't do much if you were not assigned to something, I came up with an idea for you. I'm gonna assign you to take care of one of our classmates that might really help.

Jake doesn't like the way the talk is turning.

JAKE

What do you mean?

JENNIFER

I'm going to assign you to take care of Will Roberts, the new transfer kid who is in the wheelchair.

JAKE

What?

JENNIFER

Look upon him and make sure he's been taking care of. Might sound simple at the beginning, but I can assure you it'll take some time, so that's all I'm gonna give you.

JAKE

What? No! I'm not doing that! I'm not babysitting nobody!

DYLAN

I think it's more like a friend than a babysi--

JAKE

You don't get into this!

JENNIFER

I'm not going to argue with you. That's going to be your assignment, and for the sake of our grades, the project or whatever you value the most, do as I say, take care of that kid.

JAKE

What? What am I going to do with him?

The bells RINGS. Jennifer looks at her watch.

JENNIFER

Well, that's all. We need to leave, we have a test today.

All of them start packing their stuff to leave. Jake stays in his place.

JAKE

Hey! What am I even suppose to do?

JENNIFER

(leaving)

You're a smart guy, figure it out.

DYLAN

(leaving disappointed)

Hmm, I didn't even have a chance to present my ideas.

All of them start to head out. Jake remains in his seat.

DYLAN

So, anyone wants to hear what I did in our way to the cafeteria?

INT. BMA HALL - DAY

There are kids rushing to get to their classrooms.

NARRATOR (V. O.)

The course was already on mid term.

Test were already happening so the nerves were at point.

INT. CLASSROOM - DAY

The kids are taking a test while the teacher walks in between them watching them. Benjamin is counting with his fingers trying to get the right answer. Jake is having a little trouble with solving his. Jennifer is doing very well and seems confident with her answers. On the corner is Will. He is one of the first ones to finish and heads up to deliver his test, but as he is on a wheelchair, it takes him some time to get thru there. It makes a FUNNY NOISE as he advances. Jennifer looks at him for a while then gets an idea. She turns and look at Jake.

NARRATOR (V. O.)

Everybody was trying to give their best and the effort invested during the first months was already giving results.

INT. CLASSROOM - DAY

Eddy is answering his test very confident. He is the first one to finish, but he stays sitted just waiting for someone else to be first. Rodi seems to be very stressed. Anna also seems to be having some trouble answering his test. Zero is hitting his head trying to think on the answers. Skinny is praying trying to get answers.

SKINNY

God, I never ask you much, but please help me remember this one.

Nick is trying to fill everything really quick and as soon as he is over, he rushes to turn it down. Proud of himself he looks back at Eddy and makes a gesture of superiority.

NARRATOR (V. O.)

For Eddy, being the smartest wasn't an idea of himself he wanted to transmit, so he let Nick enjoy his win this time.

The BELL RINGS.

INT. BMA HALL - DAY

All the kids are getting out of their classroom. All of them are talking about how they did in their test. Melissa is



taking some stuff from her locker. Erika is next to her.

ERIKA

And it was kind of weird, just as a miracle. Suddenly the answer pop up and I was speeding faster than a lighting and preciselier than a scalpel filling all the question. I wish mamma was here to see her girl on fire.

Melissa smiles when suddenly Jennifer appears next to them. She is holding a box full of stuff. Next to her is Nugget, who seems a little uncomfortable, but happy that is receiving some help.

JENNIFER

Wait here, Nu... Michael.  
(turns to Melissa)  
Hey I need to talk to you a second.

Melissa seems a little nervous.

INT. BATHROOM - DAY

Melissa is entering the bathroom a little shy and slow. She seems a little nervous. Melissa realizes there is someone SOBBING in there.

NARRATOR (V. O.)

As Jennifer was already busy trying to help Nugget, she decided to give Melissa a new assignment. She wasn't really sure she would be able to handle it, but still she decided to take the risk and let her do the job.

Melissa kneels down and realizes there is someone in the bathroom crying. She starts thinking for a while her next movement and what is she going to do.

MELISSA

(shy and nervous)  
Hey! Are you ok?

There is no answer, but the SOBBING stops. Melissa waits for an answer for a few seconds.

MELISSA

(nervous)  
I can... help you? If you need

anything.

There is no answer. Melissa doesn't know what to do.

EXT. BATHROOM - DAY

Melissa heads out of the bathroom without knowing what to do and a little uncomfortable.

MELISSA  
(to herself)  
Forget it. I'm not good at this and no  
one is going to realize...

Suddenly she realizes there is one henchman in the office in front of her. He turns and look at her. She kind of gets more nervous and gets inside the bathroom again.

INT. BMA HALL - DAY

Erika is sitted on the lobby with her notebooks trying to study. She sees Melissa approaching.

ERIKA  
There you are, you sure took your--

MELISSA  
I need your help with something.

INT. BATHROOM - DAY

Erika and Melissa enter a little slowly. Erika doesn't understand exactly what they are doing there. Melissa points the bathroom. The two of them start to kneel down to see if someone is there.

ERIKA  
(whispering while kneeling)  
Are you really sure is this?

MELISSA  
(whispering)  
Yeah, I'm sure is here. I saw it a few  
minutes ago.

ERIKA  
(whispering)  
Well, I don't see nothing he...

Suddenly the DOOR opens giving a SLOW CRACKING. The two of them still kneeled on the floor look up slowly. In front of

them is WENDY (14), a freshmen. She is looking at them kind of weird.

WENDY

What are you doing?

Melissa hides behind Erika a little nervous.

ERIKA

Well... we were... just... I mean...

There is a moment of awkward silence.

ERIKA

We just heard someone... here and we just wanted to see if whoever was there was okay.

Wendy sighs and just relays on the wall.

WENDY

Yeah, that was me.

Erika and Melissa looks at her without knowing what to do.

ERIKA

Ah... are you okay now?

WENDY

Well... I suppose.

ERIKA

What was the problem? What made you get inside the bathroom to cry?

WENDY

Math I guess. You see... I studied hard yesterday for this test, and I even went to sleep late, but somehow when I started taking the test, I couldn't remember anything. I was completely in white! I surely did terrible in that exam, I'm gonna fail this test.

ERIKA

Oh, come on! There should never be tears over a battle that hasn't even started. Cheer up! We haven't got our results yet, who knows the final outcome of them. It might surprise

you. You said it yourself, you studied hard for this, I'm sure you'll be fine.

WENDY  
You really think so?

ERIKA  
Yeah, why not?

MELISSA  
Don't worry about it, you'll be fine.

Wendy thinks about it for a moment.

WENDY  
Well... I ain't gonna lie, it ain't the best speech I've ever heard, but it wasn't bad either. I guess you might be right.

Erika and Melissa just look at each other.

WENDY  
Even if the final result doesn't reflect what I expected, well... at least I tried to give my best.

ERIKA  
You got it right.

Wendy smiles now. Melissa looks proud how well Erika handled the situation. Suddenly the other door of the bathroom opens and LISA (17), another girl, gets out of there. The three girls look at her.

LISA  
Thank you, I needed that too.

INT. BMA HALL, OUTSIDE THE GIRL'S BATHROOM - DAY

Erika and Melissa are leaving the bathroom. Lisa and Wendy are taking different paths.

ERIKA  
Why did you wanted to help her?

MELISSA  
Just because.

INT. GYM - AFTERNOON

Jake is by his own spiking the ball to the wall.

JAKE  
(to himself)  
Taking care of that wheelchair dude,  
whatever, I'm not doing nothing.

After a few minutes he goes to the volleyball court to try to serve. He do it a few times, but he's always failing.

JAKE  
(to himself)  
Why do I suck so much at this?

Suddenly he hears those weird NOISES again close to him and turns to try to see what it is. But there is no one there. A little distracted he keeps playing.

INT. GAZEBO - DAY

Jennifer is thinking and walking in circles. Over the table are a few books and her notebook of Life choices. Also there is a paper with vocabulary that Elsa gave her.

JENNIFER  
(trying her best to pronounce  
correctly but is in vain)  
Você precisa de uma mão?, Você precisa  
de uma mão?, Você precisa de uma mão?

She hits her head trying to do it better and a little stressful.

JENNIFER  
(to herself)  
Oh my godness. If I'm not getting any better... well, that already know, I'm not improving at all! This is not for me that is for sure. I'm gonna have to think about something else. Spanish? No, I think that's even worse. Italian, Korean, French? Hmm, no, I don't think so. They are gonna take still time to master. But on the other hand everything takes time to master, so... is it the language or is it me?  
(thinking)  
No, who am I kidding... I never had the liking to this area anyways...

(short pause)  
 Hmm, there'll be many other options.  
 Yeah! There always are!

Elsa approaches with some books.

ELSA  
 (trying to make a joke)  
 Hey, how's everything going? Ready for  
 the next class? Last one was tough,  
 and this is going to be even harder.

Elsa laughs while Jennifer turns to look at her and then  
 stays still.

JENNIFER  
 Hey, Elsa. There's something you need  
 to know. You can call me a quitter, but  
 I just realize this might not be my  
 thing. I'm sorry for taking up your  
 time, I I'm sorry for taking up your  
 time, I promise I'll make it up to  
 you, but I think I'm done with  
 portugues.

Elsa just looks at Jennifer a little mad.

ELSA  
 Well, you certainly took your time.

Elsa closes her book while on screen appears the option  
 LANGUAGE LEARNING and it crosses it out.

INT. AGRICULTURE - DAY

All the sophomore kids are working in the farm. NICK, the  
 agriculture teacher, is supervising while the students work.  
 Eddy and his friends are taking out some bad herbs in the  
 ground. Not too far from them, is Anna and Zoe working by  
 their own.

SKINNY  
 (talking quietly)  
 I heard Timmy just received the new  
 shoes from his grandmother in Alaska,  
 man I bet those ones can make up for  
 the last time in the Christmas  
 Concert.

ADAM  
 Oh yeah, that's true!

(taking out the Ownership book)  
Should we take it into consideration?  
I can erase his name now and we'll  
make sure he pays later.

ZERO

Yeah, we can make sure really well.

Suddenly Nick and Rodi approaches them. They are holding a lot of grass with their gloves.

NICK

Still playing with dirt, kids?

RODI

Yeah, I can see some dirt there.

All of them look at them.

EDDY

We are all messing with dirt, Nick,  
that's the main source of farm  
assignments.

NICK

Whatever, man. I just wanted to remind  
you that yesterday  
(making a proud pose)  
I kill the test. I was on fire.

RODI

You bet he was!

ADAM

You don't even know it yet, we haven't  
got our results.

NICK

No, but I trust my instincts and they  
sure are shining bright my future. My  
papa used to say that success runs  
through my family veins.

RODI

But you said your cousin wasn't doing  
good on her--

NICK

Ah, ah, ah. Don't spoil family  
bussiness.

EDDY  
So Anna didn't do well in her test?

RODI  
She didn't.

NICK  
Bro, can you just don't say anything?

RODI  
Sorry.

Eddy just smiles.

NARRATOR (V. O.)  
So this was it. A few seconds that helped Eddy earn the confident he needed. He never liked to brag about his intelligence, but if this could be an ice breaker to get closer to Anna, he was ready to take it.

INT. BMA HALLS - DAY

Jake is walking in the halls, a lot of students are passing by. He passes near to a classroom where he sees Dylan cleaning a window. He's still walking while looking at Dylan working, when he strumbles with Will in front of him, who is moving in a slow rhythm.

WILL  
Hey, watch out, dude!

JAKE  
My bad, man.

Jake looks in front of him and notices Will is looking at him angry.

WILL  
Of course, it wasn't mine!

JAKE  
All right, chill out.

WILL  
Easy to say, not to achieve.

JAKE  
(trying to get away)  
Whatever.



Jake moves and goes straight to his locker while Will tries to keep advancing in the wheelchair, but in the movement his water bottle drops out of the wheelchair and goes out of his reach. Jake sees him from the distance. Will advance to grab the bottle, but when he tries to pick it up, it results very difficult for him. Jake just looks at him while taking his stuff out of his locker. Will tries to pick up the bottle, but he can't. Jake closes his backpack once he puts everything in there and comes closer to Will. He is still struggling to pick up his bottle. Jake leans down and picks up the bottle. Without saying a word just give it to Will. He doesn't say anything either and takes the bottle.

INT. LIBRARY - DAY

Jennifer is writing in her computer. She haven't touch the keys for a long time, she's still thinking while looking at the screen. Besides her, she has her notebook with the section: WRITING A BOOK underlined. In the computer, she only have written a single paragraph: BOOK IDEAS, but the list is still empty. After a long time she crosses out the section, closes her computer and leaves the library.

NARRATOR (V. O.)

Now that Jennifer had discard the idea of becoming a language master, she had to think about something else to try. Many ideas came to her mind, but she still had to try them and realize if they will really work or not. At least now she knew writing a book was not her thing.

INT. BMA HALL - DAY

Dylan finishes cleaning the window and he's packing everything to leave. He notices he left a small spot not that shiny and he takes the wiper and cleans it quickly.

DYLAN

That's better.

Dylan takes out his list and checks the part of: HELP CLEANING THE SCHOOL SOMEHOW. Dylan looks at the window and thinks for a while.

DYLAN

(to himself)

Common' there must be something else I can do, something more meaningful.

TREVOR (V.O.)  
I'm telling you, man. I'm in real trouble. If I don't get more than a B+ I'll be history.

DANIEL (V.O.)  
Come on, bro! You have to worry less and live more!

TREVOR (V.O.)  
How can I even stop worrying? That test was a killer, no one was safe in there.

Dylan still looking at his clean window hears them talk.

DANIEL (V.O.)  
Man, seriously, calm down! You're even shaking.

TREVOR (V.O.)  
I don't know bro.

Dylan takes his cleaning stuff and walk away, he passes near Trevor and Daniel and keeps going.

INT. LAUNDRY ROOM - NIGHT

Jennifer is trying to get ideas for the book she was trying to write. Her notebook has some ideas, but none of them look really interesting to her. Dissapointed she closes her notebook and finally realize that there are some other girls in the laundry also that she didn't knew as she was fully concentrated in her things. The two girls in there seem to have some issues understanding how the laundrymat works. She look at them for a while.

JENNIFER  
(to herself)  
Girls these days doesn't know the real stuff.

Jennifer get closer to them.

JENNIFER  
Hey do you need a hand?

The two girls look at her.

INT. LAUNDRY ROOM - NIGHT

Jennifer is helping them with the last procedure.

JENNIFER

And once you put the softener you are good to go.

Jennifer presses a button and the machine starts to run.

GIRL 1

Wow, you sure are the best.

GIRL 2

We were trying to understand what does that mean, you see, english is not our first language.

JENNIFER

Oh so, where are you all from?

Jennifer and the girls keep talking for a while. A smile shows in Jennifer's face as she talks.

NARRATOR (V. O.)

And even when she wasn't looking for it, suddenly Jennifer got an idea of what she could do. She realize there might be a lot of girls who need help on the dorms, and she could use her time and try to teach them any stuff they needed.

In the screen it writes: TEACHING & TOURING.

INT. DYLAN'S ROOM - NIGHT

Dylan is making some origami figures in his room. He's very concentrated. Tucker is playing in his phone a game.

TUCKER

Come on, dude! It's the only time we can have our phones! You better play this game!

DYLAN

I'm sorry, I'm doing something really important now.

TUCKER

More important than "Speeders in

*Fire*", I don't think so.

Dylan keeps working on his pieces. At the end, when he have all his figures, he writes something on them.

DYLAN

Bro, this is going to be...

BOYS DEAN (MIC)

Lights are about to be turn off in 15 minutes, so get ready to sleep.

TUCKER

Oh dang! I have to turn back my phone.

INT. MELISSA'S ROOM - NIGHT

Erika and Melissa are ready to go to sleep, both of them are in pijamas getting comfy in their respective beds.

ERIKA

Well, we survived another day.

Melissa is already in her bed just listening to her.

ERIKA

Wasn't today crazy?

MELISSA

Yeah, it was.

ERIKA

It still keeps bothering me... Why did you wanted to help that girl? I mean, nothing bad with that, but, why particularly you? Why did you wanted to do it?

Melissa thinks for a while without knowing what to say.

ERIKA

I've gotta tell you that I'm not a big fan of "just because" or "I don't know" answers. You have to give me something.

MELISSA

Aa...

NARRATOR (V. O.)

My friends, what to do in this

situation? Should she tell her about the secret BMA Ambassadors Project? Should she lie about it? Should she pretend like she's already sleep? Options were many, but for Melissa there was something very clear. She realized how she had found in Erika a good friend. Someone meaningful in this new stage of life. She was definitely a real friend. So, she did what she wouldn't had done in any other situation.

MELISSA

Can you keep a secret?

Melissa starts talking about the BAP to Erika, while a SLOW ZOOM OUT, put us far away from them.

INT. DYLAN'S ROOM - NIGHT

Tucker is coming back from the office and opens the door.

TUCKER

Man, I was about to beat the final boss...

DYLAN

... and please help also those who didn't do much well in the other's day test and gives them wisdom to do better on the next one.

Dylan is kneeled down next to his bed. Tucker enters trying not to make much noise and gets in his bed looking at Dylan a little intrigued.

DYLAN

Now that I'm going to sleep I ask you to give me strenghts for tomorrow and a nice actitude. In Jesus name, amen.

Dylan gets in his bed. Tucker just keeps thinking in his bed.

DYLAN

Good night, Tucker.

INT. BMA HALL - DAY

Everybody is looking at their grades, now that they have been delivered. A lot of people is happy that they got a good

grade. Jake doesn't mind that much, Jennifer has an A+ as usual. Nugget is running in the hall showing the B- that he got.

NUGGET

Oh yeah! I outstaged myself this time!  
I'm a legend.

HENCHMAN

Hey, no running in the hall.

Nugget stops running, just exactly where Trevor and Daniel are looking at their scores.

TREVOR

I'm telling you, man. I was never worried, I knew about my potential. Being worried is not part of me.

DANIEL

If you said so. What is that?

Daniel points at an origami figure in Trevor's locker.

TREVOR

Oh, I don't know. Somebody put it in there I guess. It is cool though, it even had a message inside, look.

Trevor shows the figure to Daniel, while Dylan pass just right by them. He hears that and smiles. He keeps walking and gets closer to Wendy who is talking with Melissa and Erika.

WENDY

(happy)

You were right, there was nothing to worry about. I did just great!

ERIKA

Of course there wasn't!

Dylan keeps walking and gets closer to Jennifer who has a "teaching" book with her.

DYLAN

(extending his hand to her)

JENNIFER

What is this?

DYLAN  
Just a gift.

Jennifer takes the gift, it is an origami figure of the classic hat. It says in there: BEST CAPTAIN (LEADER) EVER. Dylan smiles and keeps walking.

DYLAN  
(walking away)  
You can use it as a hat, if you hadn't notice.

JENNIFER  
Oh, thank you!

Dylan without even turning back makes a sign with his hand as a captain saying farewell. Jennifer looks at the hat with a sincere smile.

INT. CLASSROOM - DAY

Everybody are comparing their results with each other. Some of them are excited some other are worried. Nick is looking at his not very satisfied. He has a B+. Rodi shows him his very proud. He has an A. Nick takes it surprised.

NICK  
Wait, what?

Eddy is holding his paper. He has a clear A+. There are some people around him comparing their answer with his.

ANNA (V. O.)  
Wow, an A+? That's pretty impressive.

Eddy recognizes the voice and turns to look at her. Anna is just next to him. Their friends take away the paper and they put it over a table to compare them better.

EDDY  
(nervous)  
Tha... thanks. I... is not a big deal. You know... the usual. And I don't mean to brag about it, is just something I'm used to.

ANNA  
I kind of figured you were some kind of nerd. Not trying to offend.

EDDY

(nervous)

I'm a nerd... I mean, I can be your nerd. Sorry, I meant that I study hard and perhaps I'm a nerd and...

(changing the subject nervously)

So what was your score?

ANNA

Not as good as yours that for sure. I mean, is not that bad, but still not that good. I'm sure I can do better if I had study more.

EDDY

I can help you study if you need it. Not that you need it, I guess you are doing very well on...

Eddy looks at her paper, she has a C+.

ANNA

Hey, that wouldn't be that bad. You can share with us a little piece of your brain.

EDDY

My brain? O... oh I see what you meant! My brain! Sure! Yeah, sure!

Eddy makes a goofy sign of taking her brain out and laughs alone by it. His friends are looking at him from aside a little weird.

SKINNY

I think we have lost a brother in the deceptive sweeties of love.

NARRATOR (V. O.)
